



**Statements regarding CE compliance
for
products exported to the European Union**

These statements pertain to all products exported by Persistor Instruments Inc (PII) to product developers and researchers in the European Union. The items are exported under the HS Schedule B category 8471607000 "Units suitable for incorporation into automatic data processing machines or units thereof".

Low Voltage Directive (LVD) 2006/95/EC

The computer and computer peripherals that PII manufactures and exports to the EU are **exempt** from the provisions of this directive because they are designed for use with a voltage rating of less than 20 volts DC which is below the applicable limits of the directive (between 75 and 1500 volts DC).

Electromagnetic Compatibility Directive (EMC) 2004/108/EC

The computer and computer peripherals that PII manufactures and exports to the EU are **exempt** from the provisions of this directive based on the Directive introduction article (11) :

Where this Directive regulates apparatus, it should refer to finished apparatus commercially available for the first time on the Community market. Certain components or sub-assemblies should, under certain conditions, be considered to be apparatus if they are made available to the end user.

The computer and computer peripherals that PII exports are electronic components that must be combined with additional electronics developed by the importer and placed in an enclosure provided by the importer that will significantly affect the electromagnetic compatibility of the apparatus being manufactured by the importer (which may become an installation) of which PII does not participate in the design, configuration, placement, or electromagnetic shielding. PII asserts it is the responsibility of the importer to ensure the completed apparatus or installation is compliant with this directive if and when the apparatus or installation being manufactured by the importer becomes commercially available for the first time on the Community market. None of the items exported by PII are made available to the end user except by the importer who is the designer and manufacturer of the finished apparatus or installation.

The memory cards that PII exports are marked with the CE label by the original manufacturer.
