

Installing CodeWarrior on Windows 7

CodeWarrior Development Studio for Palm OS version 9.3 will work in Windows 7, both Win7-32 and Win7-64.

Use the CF2 Getting Started Guide instructions to install them.

Do not try to register CodeWarrior or look for updates. You can no longer register it and there are no updates.

After installing, check to make sure these two directories exist;

C:\Program Files\Persistor\MotoCross Support\

C:\Program Files\Metrowerks\CodeWarrior\

Depending on the Windows settings, the installer roots may have been redirected.

If that happened, move the entire directories to the C:\ root.

After installing, go into Program Files explorer, right click on the target top folder (e.g. Metrowerks, Persistor), click Security, click Edit..., click Users (..someLocalName.), click Full Control Allow [X], OK, and OK.

Then read the notice "Running CodeWarrior on Windows 7" to avoid spurious crashes.

Before trying to move or use any old CodeWarrior projects, try the "YOUR FIRST PROJECT" on page 13 of the CF2 getting started guide. It should work. If it doesn't, recheck the installation is at these locations;

C:\Program Files\Persistor\MotoCross Support\

C:\Program Files\Metrowerks\CodeWarrior\

and review your security preferences as described above.
